- Age 6 and kindergarten children are eligible for our Tee Ball League.
- Age 7 players are eligible for our Cap League, but first year players may prefer Tee Ball.
- Age 8 players are eligible for cap league but MAY try-out for our minor league division. They will be evaluated by our coaching staff at our rating assessment to determine their capabilities.
- Age 9 players are eligible for our minor league and will be evaluated at our rating assessment to determine their capabilities.
- Age 10 players are eligible for our minor league but MAY try-out for our major league division. They will be evaluated by our coaching staff at our rating assessment to determine their capabilities.
- Age 11 players are eligible for our major league and will be evaluated at our rating assessment to determine their capabilities.
- Age 12 players are eligible for our major league division only.
- Ages 13/ 14 / 15 are eligible for Babe Ruth level. We may field teams for 50/70 division and 60/90 division.

* While your child is eligible, based on age, to participate at a certain level/division, there will be a skills assessment for any child wishing to participate in either the Minor or Major Divisions. For safety reasons, this skills assessment will SUPERSEDE age to determine the division your child would participate.

PARENT'S--CODE OF CONDUCT

I as a parent of a youth sport participant agree to the following rules & regulations set forth by the East Hanover Recreation Department.

- *I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- *I will remember that the game is for the children not the adults.
- *I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child and the safety of others.
- *I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.
- *I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game and practice.
- *I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player or parent such as booing, taunting, profane language or gestures.
- *I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- *I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- *I will respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss or confront coaches at the game field.
- *I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.

I agree to abide by all rules and policies as set forth by the East Hanover Recreation Department. I also understand if I violate any of the rules, regulations or policies I will lose the privilege of watching my child in any township sporting event for the year and will be on probation for the following year.
