

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Township Council of the Township of East Hanover held on Monday, August 1, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. in the Municipal Building, 411 Ridgedale Avenue, East Hanover, New Jersey.

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

OLD BUSINESS:

Public Hearing: Ordinance No. 5-2016~ Amend and Supplement Chapter 19, Court Municipal, to Add New Section 19-11 Prosecutor, Assistant Prosecutors

The Township Clerk announced that she had Ordinance No. 5-2016, entitled "*AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE TOWNSHIP CODE TO ADD A NEW SECTION 19-11. PROSECUTOR, ASSISTANT PROSECUTORS TO CHAPTER 19, COURT MUNICIPAL.*"

The Mayor stated they would now hold a public hearing on Ordinance No. 5-2016.

Public Hearing: Ordinance No. 6-2016~ Amend and Supplement Chapter 155, Vehicles and Traffic, Article X, Traffic Regulations, to Add New Section §155-25.4 U-Turn Prohibited

The Township Clerk announced that she had Ordinance No. 6-2016, entitled “*AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EAST HANOVER, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE TOWNSHIP CODE CHAPTER 155, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE X, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS TO ADD A NEW SECTION §155-25.4. U-TURN PROHIBITED.*”

The Mayor stated they would now hold a public hearing on Ordinance No. 6-2016.

James Carollo, 31 Rebecca Road, questioned if the ordinance would also pertain to a no u-turn at Hanover Park Condominiums and if not, what was being done about the situation. The Mayor explained that the Township must revisit the traffic flow issue of vehicles entering and exiting at Castle Ridge Plaza.
